Production of eggs in Canada I/ during December, ByPditatd EेQUE 41.8 million dozen, was 2.0 per cent more than the 41.0 million dozen produced in December 1959. Although there were slightly fewer layers than a year earlier the rate of lay increased from 1,605 to 1,638 eggs per hundred layers. Revised estimates for the last 7 months of 1960, based on the December Semi-Annual Crop and Livestock Survey, will be published in the Jamuary issue of this report.

Egg production during December was 3.8 per cent higher than in November. The normal seasonal increase occurred because a higher rate of lay more than offset a 2.0 per cent decrease in the number of layers.

Froducer sales of market eggs during December are estimated at 36.4 miliion dozen compared with 36.0 million in December 1959. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly survey was 40.6 cents per dozen in November and 35.9 in December. The corrosponding farm prices reported in November and December 1959 were 34.1 and 27.0 cents, respectively.

The preliminary estimate of egg production during 1960 was 457.1 million dozen, a decrease of .6 per cent or 2.9 million dozen less than in 1959. For each of the first 6 months of the year less oggs were produced than in the corresponding months of 1959 while the opposite was true for the last six months of the year.

FROZEN EGG: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspectIon reporting to the Department of Agriculture during December 1960 was 181,580 pounds as compared with 498,126 pounds in December 1959.
