PRODUCTION OF EGGS<br>AUGUST 1960

The estimated production of eggs in Canada I/ during August at 34.9 million dozen was 4.4 per cent more than the 33.4 million dozen produced in August 1959. This increase resulted from a higher rate of lay and 1.1 per cent more layers than last year. Production from Jamary to August 1960 was 302.0 million dozen eggs, 3.2 per cent less than for the same period last year.

Egg production during August "was 1.7 per cent lower than in July. This decrease occurred because the seasonal decrease in the rate of lay from 1,656 in July to 1,530 in August more than offset a 6.2 per cent increase in the number of layers. A substantial number of pullets commenced to lay in August.

Producer sales of market eggs during August are estimated at 29.8 million dozen compared with 28.3 million in August 1959. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly survey increased from 33.4 cents in July to 38.5 cents in August. The corresponding farm price reported in August 1959 was 33.2 cents.

FROZEN EGG: Processing to frozen egs in all piants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during August 1960 was $2,004,423$ pounds as compared with $3,677,215$ pounds in August 1959.
