PRODUCTIONOFEGGS
April 1961

The estimated production of egzs in Canada 1 during April at 39.1 million dozen was 0.2 per cent more than the 39.0 million dozen produced in April 1960. Although the number of layers declinad by 0.2 per cent to 27.0 million the rate of lay increased from 1,745 to 1,752 . In March the number of layers was 0.4 per cent less than during the sarse month last year.

Producer sales of market eggs during April are estimated at 31.6 million dozen compared with 31.5 million dozen in April 1960. The average price of eggs to producers, as reported in the monthly sample survey, was 32.1 cents per dozen in March and 31.2 cents per dozen in April. The corresponding larm prices reported in March and April 1960 were 32.6 and 33.6 cents, respectively.

Egg production in the flust four months of 1961 was 156.3 million dozen an increase of 1.3 per cent from the Jamuary to April production in 1960. This output was obtained from 0.6 per cent fewer layers than last year.

FROZEN EGCS: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the four week pericd ending April 29, 1961 was 1,850,777 pounds as compared with $2,449,786$ pounds during the corresponding period in 1960.
