PRODUCTION OF EGGS


The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during April at 39.1 million dozen was 0.2 per cent more than the 39.0 million dozen produced in April 1960. Although the number of layers declined by 0.2 per cent to 27.0 million the rate of lay increased from 1,745 to 1,752. In March the number of layers was 0.4 per cent less than during the same month last year.

Producer sales of market eggs during April are estimated at 31.6 million dozen compared with 31.5 million dozen in April 1960. The average price of eggs to producers, as reported in the monthly sample survey, was 32.1 cents per dozen in March and 31.2 cents per dozen in April. The corresponding farm prices reported in March and April 1960 were 32.6 and 33.6 cents, respectively.

Egg production in the first four months of 1961 was 156.3 million dozen an increase of 1.3 per cent from the January to April production in 1960. This output was obtained from 0.6 per cent fewer layers than last year.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the four week period ending April 29, 1961 was 1,850,777 pounds as compared with 2,449,786 pounds during the corresponding period in 1960.
