PRODUCTIONOF EGGS

The estimated production of eggs in Canada $1 /$ during November at 34.8 million dozen was 3.0 per cent less than the 35.9 million dozen produced in November 1961. Although the rate of lay was the same as in November 1961 the number of layers at 27.1 million was 3.1 per cent less than a year earlier. In October the number of layers was 1.9 per cent lower than during the same month last year.

Producer sales of market eggs during November are estimated at 31.3 million dozen, 3.2 per cent less than in November 1961. The average price of eggs to producers, as reported in the monthly sample survey was 39.5 cents per dozen in October and 41.4 cents per dozen in November. The corresponding farm prices reported in October and November 1961 were 40.3 and 40.5 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates, egg production in the first eleven months of 1962 was 392.1 million dozen, an increase of 1.0 per cent from the 388.1 million dozen produced during the corresponding period in 1961.

FROZEN EGG: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the four week period ending December 1 was 377,283 pounds as compared with 690,169 pounds during the corresponding period in 1961.
