Estimated production of eggs in Canada $1 /$ BIBLIOTHEQQdur ing July at 36.2 million dozen was 4.4 per cent more then the 34.7 million dozen produced in July 1961. The estimated number of layers at 25.7 million was 1.7 percent higher than a year earlier and the rate of lay increased by 2.7 per cent to 1,707 eggs per 100 layers. In June the number of layers was 2.6 per cent higher than during the same month last year.

Producer sales of market eggs during July are estimated at 30.4 million dozen compared with 29.0 million dozen in July 1961. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly sample surveys was 29.6 cents per dozen in June and 31.1 cents per dozen in July. The corresponding farm prices reported in June and July 1961 were 33.8 and 37.6 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates, egg production in the first seven months of 1962 was 269.9 million dozen, an increase of 2.1 per cent from the 264.3 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1961.
