Estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during October at 34.1 million dozen was 0.3 per cent less than the 34.2 million dozen produced in October 1962. The estimated number of layers at 27.2 million was 1.3 per cent lower than a year earlier while the rate of lay increased by 1.0 per cent to 1,516 eggs per 100 layers.

Sales of market eggs during October are estimated at 30.5 million dozen compared with 30.6 million dozen in October 1962. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly survey was 42.7 cents per dozen in October and 43.9 cents per dozen in September. The corresponding farm prices reported in October and September 1962 were 39.5 and 37.2 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates, egg production in the first ten months of 1963 was 346.4 million dozen, down 3.9 per cent from the 360.5 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1962.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the five week period ending November 2 was 499,344 pounds as compared with 1,003,960 pounds during the corresponding period in 1962.
