PRODUCTIONOF EGGS
YOVEMBER1963

Estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/during November at 35.3 million dozen was 1.0 per cent less than the 35.7 million dozen produced in November 1962. The estimated number of layers at 27.3 million was 1.8 per cent lower than a year earlier while the rate of lay increased by 0.8 per cent to 1,563 eggs per 100 layers.

Sales of market eggs during November are estimated at 31.6 million dozen compared with 32.2 million dozen in November 1962. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly survey was 38.3 cents per dozen in November and 42.7 cents per dozen in October. The corresponding farm prices reported in November and October 1962 were 41.4 and 39.5 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates, egg production in the first eleven months of 1963 was 381.7 million dozen, down 3.6 per cent from the 396.2 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1962 .

FROZEN EGCS: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the four week period ending November 30 was 535,266 pounds as compared with 377,283 pounds during the corresponding period in 1962.
