## PRODUCTIONOF EGGS

## DECEMBER1963

The estimated production of eggs in daneda 1 OTHEQUE during December at 36.6 million dozen was 3.8 per cent less than the 38.0 million dozen produced in December 1962. Although the rate of lay was approximately the same as in December 1962 the number of layers at 26.4 million was 4.1 per cent less than a year earlier.

Sales of market eggs by producers during December are estimated at 32.3 million dozen, 4.9 per cent less than in December 1962. The average price of eggs to producers, as reported in the monthly sample survey was 36.0 cents per dozen in December compared to 38.3 cents per dozen in November. The corresponding farm prices reported in December and November 1962 were 35.2 and 41.4 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates, egg production in 1963 was 418.3 million dozen, a decrease of 3.7 per cent from the 434.2 million dozen produced during 1962.

FROZEN EGG: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the four week period ending December 28 was 476,400 pounds as compared with 340,628 pounds during the corresponding period in 1962.
