PRODUCTIONOF EGGS<br>JUNE 1963

Estimated production of eggs in Canada $1 /$ during June at 33,870 million dozen was 3.9 per cent less than the 35,233 million dozen produced in June 1962. The estimated number of layers at 23,810 million was 2.8 per cent lower than a year earlier while the rate of lay decreased by 1.0 per cent to 1,723 eggs per 100 lajers.

Sales of market eggs during June are estimated at 29,272 million dozen compared with 31,128 million dozen in June 1962. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly survey was 34.8 cents per dozen in June and 35.1 cents per dozen in May. The corresponding farm prices reported in June and May 1962 were 29.8 and 29.4 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates, egg production in the first six months of 1963 was 217,063 million dozen, down 2.8 per cent from the 223,193 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1962.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the four week period ending June 29 was 2,385,269 pounds as compared wi th 2,968,607 pounds during the corresponding period in 1962.
