## PRODUCTION OF EGGS

October 1964

Estimated production of eggs in Canada (1) during October at 36.2 million dozen was 8.8 per cents more than the 33.3 million dozen produced in October 1963. The estimated number of layers at 28.2 million was 6.2 per cent higher than a year earlier while the rate of lay increased by 2.5 per cent to 1,552 eggs per 100 layers.

Sales of market eggs during October are estimated at 32.3 million dozen, 9.0 per cent more than in October 1963. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly sample survey was 30.5 cents per dozen in October and 32.5 cents per dozen in September. The corresponding farm prices reported in October and September 1963 were 42.6 and 44.0 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates egg production in the first ten months of 1964 was 361.6 million dozen, an increase of 4.5 per cent over the 346.1 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1963.

Frozen Eggs: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the five week period ending October 31 was 1,218,412 pounds as compared with 499,344 pounds during the corresponding period in 1963.
