Estimated production of eggs in Canada(l) during June at 37.2 million dozen was 5.6 per cent more than the 35.2 million dozen produced in June, 1964. The estimated number of layers at 25.8 million was 5.4 per cent higher than a year earlier and the rate of lay increased by 0.1 per cent to 1,743 eggs per 100 layers.

Sales of market eggs during June are estimated at 32.3 million dozen, 6.0 per cent more than in June, 1964. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly sample survey was 31.3 cents per dozen in June and 31.2 cents per dozen in May. The corresponding farm prices reported in June and May 1964 were 29.0 and 28.1 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates egg production in the first six months of 1965 was 231.8 million dozen, an increase of 4.1 per cent over the 222.7 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1964.

Frozen Eggs: Processing to frozen egg in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture during the four week period ending June 26 was 2,928,745 pounds as compared with $2,982,834$ pounds during the corresponding period in 1964.
