

PRODUCTION OF EGGS

November 1966



Estimated production of eggs in Canada(1) during November at 34.4 million dozen was 4.6 per cent less than the 36.1 million dozen produced in November 1965. The estimated number of layers at 27.1 million was 2.4 per cent lower than a year earlier and the rate of lay decreased 2.2 per cent to 1,538 eggs per 100 layers.

Sales of market eggs during November are estimated at 30.2 million dozen, 6.0 per cent less than in November, 1965. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly sample survey was 46.6 cents per dozen in November and 45.4 cents per dozen in October. The corresponding farm prices reported in November and 0ctober 1965 were 45.7 and 44.7 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates egg production in the first eleven months of 1966 was 377.8 million dozen, a decrease of 4.4 per cent from the 395.3 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1965.

EGG PRODUCTS: Frozen and other egg products from registered premises during the 4 week period ending December 3 was 819,521 pounds as compared with 380,900 pounds during the corresponding period in 1965 according to figures published by the Canada Department of Agriculture.
