

## PRODUCTION OF EGGS

MAY 1966

Estimated production of eggs in Canada(1) during May at 36.9 million dozen was 4.8 per cent less than the 38.7 million dozen produced in May 1965. The estimated number of layers at 24.7 million was 3.3 per cent less than a year earlier while the rate of lay decreased by 1.5 per cent to 1,804 eggs per 100 layers.

Sales of market eggs during May are estimated at 31.6 million dozen, 5.0 per cent fewer than in May 1965. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly sample survey was 38.1 cents per dozen in May and 42.3 cents per dozen in April. The corresponding farm prices reported in May and April 1965 were 31.2 and 32.2 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates egg production in the first five months of 1966 was 180.1 million dozen, a decrease of 5.4 per cent from the 190.3 milion dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1965.

Egg Products: Egg Products from registered premises during the four week period ending May 28 was $1,981,105$ pounds as compared.with $2,968,737$ pounds during the corresponding period in 1965 according to figures published by the Canada Department of Agriculture.
