## PRODUCTION OF EGGS

JUNE 1966

Estimated production of eggs in Canada(1) during June at 34.2 million dozen was 5.1 per cent less than the 36.1 million dozen produced in June 1965. The estimated number of layers at 24.1 million was 3.4 per cent less than a year earlier while the rate of lay decreased by 1.7 per cent to 1,715 eggs per 100 layers.

Sales of market eggs during June are estimated at 29.3 million dozen, 5.8 per cent fewer than in June 1965. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly sample survey was 36.3 cents per dozen in June and 38.1 cents per dozen in May. The corresponding farm prices reported in May and April 1965 were 31.3 and 31.2 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates egg production in the first six months of 1966 was 214.4 million dozen, a decrease of 5.3 per cent from the 226.4 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1965.

Egg Products: Frozen and other egg products from registered premises during the four week period ending June 25 was $2,784,412$ pounds as compared with $3,349,908$ pounds during the corresponding period in 1965 according to figures pub1ished by the Canada Department of Agriculture.
