PRODUCTION OF EGGS

SEPTEMBER 1966



Estimated production of eggs in Canada(1) during September at 31.6 million dozen was 0.7 per cent more than the 31.4 million dozen produced in September, 1965. The estimated number of layers at 25.7 million was 1.5 per cent higher than a year earlier and the rate of lay decreased 0.7 per cent to 1,488 eggs per 100 layers.

Sales of market eggs during September are estimated at 27.4 million dozen, 0.5 per cent more than in September, 1965. The average price of eggs to producers as reported in the monthly sample survey was 45.9 cents per dozen in September and 46.3 cents per dozen in August. The corresponding farm prices reported in September and August 1965 were 39.0 and 37.0 cents, respectively.

According to preliminary estimates egg production in the first nine months of 1966 was 310.8 million dozen, a decrease of 4.5 per cent over the 325.3 million dozen produced during the corresponding period of 1965.

EGG PRODUCTS: Frozen and other egg products from registered premises during the 5 week period ending October 1 was 1,023,957 pounds as compared with 1,612,656 pounds during the corresponding period in 1965 according to figures published by the Canada Department of Agriculture.
