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MONTHLY POULTRY ESTIMATES

The report on numbers of poultry on farms in Canada, as calculated from the poultry survey of June 1, 1949 was issued on November 21. Those data were related to all preliminary data in the "Monthly Poultry Estimates" of 1949 up to and including September, with a resulting decrease in average layers and a consequent reduction in total egg production. The farm net production from January 1 to October 31, 1949, with final revisions January to May inclusive, is now estimated at 256,537,000 dozens with 23,833,000 dozens produced elsewhere than on farms, giving a grand total net production of 280,370,000 dozens, as compared with the final estimate of 335,845,000 dozens for the same period in 1948.

The preliminary October 1949 estimate of the net production of eggs was 19,382,000 dozens, with eggs produced elsewhere amounting to 1,882,000 dozens, a grand total of 21,264,000 dozens. The final figures for the total in October 1948 were 21,082,000 dozens.

Farm sales of eggs for consumption during October totalled 15,884,000 dozens at a value of \$7,776,000, while farm consumption amounted to 3,507,900 dozens, which were valued at \$1,654,500.
