Lreliminary estimates show that egg production in fanada rose by 9.3 per cent from October 1966 to October 1967. The first ten months of this year show an increase in egg production of 7.2 per cent over the same period last year. The number of layers increased by 6.8 per cent from October 1966 to October 1967 and the rat of lay increased by 1.7 per cent.

According to the 1 .B.S. monthly sample survey, poultry producers recelved an average of 33.0 cents per dozen in October 1967 compared with 45.4 cents in October 1966.

Eggs in cold storage and egg stations as of November 1,1967 show a rise of 123.9 per cent over the previous year. Frozen eggs rose by 170.9 per cent while shell eggs increased by 56.4 per cent.

Egg products: Frozen and other egg products lrom registered premises, during the four week period ending October 28 , was $1,618,236$ pounds as compared with 924,590 pounds during the corresponding period in 1966. (Source "Poultry Market Keport" (anada leppartment of igriculture)
