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Preliminary estimates show that egg production in Canada rose by 11.2 per cent
from September 1966 to September 1967 . The first nine months of this year show an
increase in egg production of 6.9 per cent over the same period last year. The
number of layers increased by 6.7 per cent from September 1966 to September l967 and
the rate of lay increased by 3.4 per cent.
According to the D. B. S. monthly sample survey, poultry producers received an
average of 33.4 cents per dozen in September 1967 compared with 46.0 cents in
September 1966 .
