POULTRYBIBLISTIES

DECEMBER - 1950

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/during December was 30.3 million dozen as compared with the November estimate of 25.8 million dozen and 30.6 million dozen during December, 1949. The 4.5 million dozen increase from last month was due mainly to the seasonal increase in average egg production. The preliminary estimate 2/of production during 1950 was 353.4 million dozen, 2.8 per cent more than the revised estimate for 1949.

Average monthly egg production per hen was 10.8 eggs for December, 1950 as compared with 9.3 eggs last month and 10.7 for December, 1949.

Producers marketed an estimated 24.4 million dozen eggs during December, compared with a 21.8 million dozen during November. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during November was 4.5 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during December in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture, and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 25,951 pounds.
