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POULTRY ESTIMATES

SEPTEMBER - 1950

The estimated Canadian 1/ production of eggs during September was 24.7 million dozen as compared with the revised 2/ August estimate of 26.2 million dozen and 23.4 million dozen in September, 1949. The sharp decline in rate of lay more than offset the increase in number of hens over last month, resulting in the estimated 1.5 million decrease in production. The revised 2/ estimate of production during the first nine months of 1950 is 276.3 million dozen, 4.9 per cent more than the final estimate for the same period in 1949.

Average monthly egg production per hen was 10.6 for September, 1950 as compared with 12.4 last month and 10.1 for September, 1949. This seasonal decrease occurred in every province, with the sharpest declines being in Nova Scotia and the Prairie Provinces.

Producers marketed approximately 19.5 million dozen eggs during September, compared with a revised 2/ estimate of 20.6 million dozen during August. This total was composed of 19.4 million dozen sold for consumption and 100 thousand dozen sold for hatching. The estimated number of eggs consumed by producers during August is 5.2 million dozen.

Frozen Eggs: Production of frozen eggs during August in all plants under inspection to the Department of Agriculture, and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 579,000 pounds, compared to the corrected total of 486,000 pounds during August.

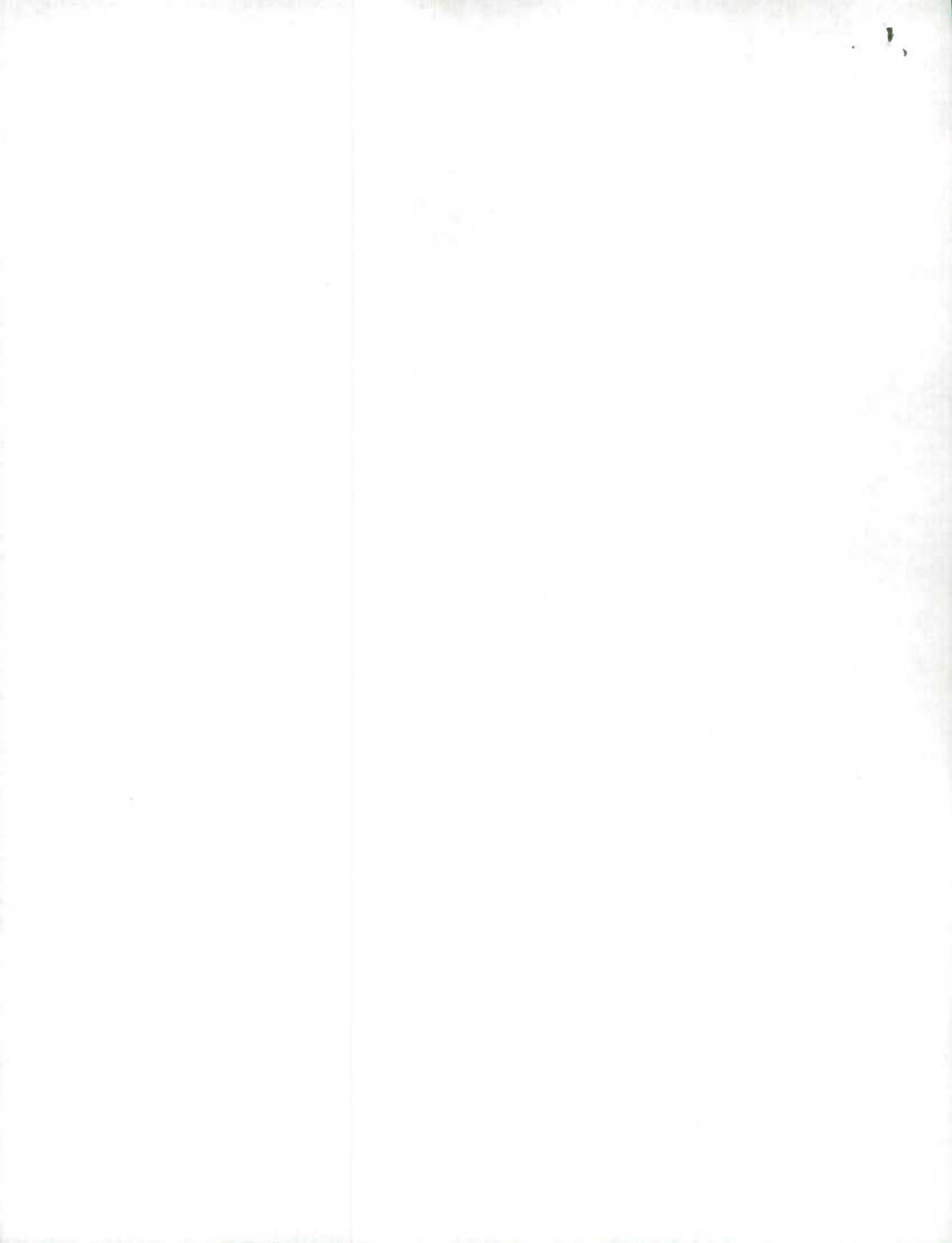
