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POULTRY ESTIMATES

OCTOBER 1951

The estimated production of eggs in Canada $\frac{1}{2}$ during October was 31.6 million dozen as compared with the September estimate of 27.4 million dozen and 21.0 million dozen during October, 1950. The estimate of egg production during the first ten months of 1951 was 288.5 million dozen compared to 284.9 million dozen during the same ten months of 1950.

Average egg production per hen over six months during October was 13.6 eggs as compared with 14.5 eggs last month.

Producers sold 27.1 million dozen eggs for market during October compared with 22.3 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during October was 4.0 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during October, 1951, in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 396.062 pounds.
