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## POULTRY ESTIMATES

## NOVEMBER 1951

The estimated production of eggs in Canada  $\frac{1}{2}$  during November was 35.5 million dozen as compared with the October estimate of 31.6 million dozen and 22.3 million dozen during November, 1950. The estimate of egg production during the first eleven months of 1951 was 324.0 million dozen compared to 307.2 million dozen during the same eleven months of 1950.

Average egg production per hen over six months during November was 13.3 eggs as compared with 13.6 eggs last month.

Producers sold 31.4 million dozen eggs for market during November compared with 27.1 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during November was 3.6 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during November, 1951, in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 208,556 pounds.
