POULTRY ESTIMATES

MAY - 1951

The estimated production of eggs in Canada during May was 34.2 million dozen as compared with the April estimate of 34.9 million dozen and 35.6 million dozen during May, 1950. The small decrease in egg production from last month resulted from the seasonal decrease in number of hens. The estimate of egg production during the first five months of 1951 was 157.0 million dozen compared to 165.6 million dozen during the same five months of 1950.

Average monthly egg production per hen was 16.9 eggs for May as compared with 16.4 eggs last month and 17.5 for May 1950.

Producers sold 26.5 million dozen eggs for market during May compared with 26.8 million dozen during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during May was 6.2 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during May, 1951, in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,140,790 pounds as compared to a revised total of 1,265,665 pounds for April, 1951.
