POULTRY ESTIMATES

JUNE - 1951

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1 during June was 29.1 million dozen as compared with the May estimate of 34.2 million dozen and 28.9 million dozen during June 1950. The decrease in egg production from last month resulted from the seasonal decrease in number of hens. The estimate of egg production during the six months of 1951 was 186.0 million dozen compared to 194.5 million dozen during the same six months of 1950.

Average egg production per hen during the month was 15.5 eggs for June as compared with 16.9 eggs last month and 14.9 for June 1950.

Producers sold 22.8 million dozen eggs for market during June compared with 26.5 million dozen during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during June was 5.3 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during June, 1951, in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,464,363 pounds.
