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POULTRY ESTIMATES

AUGUST 1951

The estimated production of eggs in Canada during August was 25.2 million dozen as compared with the July estimate of 25.3 million dozen and 23.0 million dozen during August, 1950. The revised destimate of egg production during the first eight months of 1951 was 229.5 million dozen compared to 242.5 million dozen during the same eight months of 1950.

Average egg production per hen during August was 15.1 eggs as compared with 15.3 eggs last month and 12.3 for August 1950.

Producers sold 19.9 million dozen eggs for market during August being the same as the estimate for the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during July was 4.8 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during July, 1951, in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 1,065,321 pounds.

AUGUST 1 ESTIMATE OF TURKEY NUMBERS: Number of turkeys on Canadian farms on August 1 this year was 3,440,000, according to a special survey by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. These August 1 estimates, made for the first time this year, make available data which will be useful in assessing the supply of turkeys for the coming market season.

August 1 estimates place the number of turkeys on farms in the Prairie Provinces at 1,410,000, Ontario 840,000, Quebec 770,000, British Columbia 300,000, and the Maritime Provinces 120,000. It is expected that in succeeding years it will be possible to publish estimates for each province.
