The estimated production of eggs in Canada during September was 27.4 million dozen as compared with the August estimate of 25.2 million dozen and 21.5 million dozen during September, 1950. The revised estimate of egg production during the first nine months of 1951 was 256.9 million dozen compared to 264.0 million dozen during the same nine months of 1950.

Average egg production per hen during September was 14.5 eggs as compared with 15.1 eggs last month and 10.6 for September 1950.

Producers sold 22.3 million dozen eggs for market during September compared with 19.9 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during September was 4.5 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during September, 1951, in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 556,296 pounds.
