## ROVRMBERR 1952

The estimated production of eggs in Canada $1 /$ during November was 33.0 million dozen as compared with the october estimate of 29.7 million dozen. The estimate of egg production during the first eleven months of 1952 was 336.4 million dozer.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during November was 13.6 eggs the same as last month.

Producers sold 28.2 million dozen eggs for market during November compared with 25.5 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during November was 3.9 million dozen.

FROZEN EGOS: Production of frozen eggs during November, 1952 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 24,400 pounds.
