POULTRY ESTIMATES

DECEMBER 1952

The estimated production of eggs in Canada during December was 37.4 million dozen as compared with the November estimate of 33.0 million dozen. The estimate of egg production during 1952 was 373.8 million dozen.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during December was 14.7 eggs as compared with 13.6 during November.

Producers sold 32.3 million dozen eggs for market during December compared with 28.2 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during December was 4.3 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during December, 1952 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 44,483 pounds.
