The estimated production of eggs in Canada 2 during recruary was 37.2 million dozen as compared with the January estimate of 42.5 million dozen and 26.2 million dozen during February, 1951. The estimate of egg production during the first two months of 1952 was 79.6 million dozen compared to 54.0 million dozen during the same two months of 1951.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during February was 15.0 eggs as compared with 14.7 eggs last month.

Producers sold 27.3 million dozen eggs for market during February compared with 35.0 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during February was 4.9 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during February, 1952 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,095,600 pounds.
