## POULTRY ESTIMATES

JUNE 1952

The estimated production of eggs in Canada during June was 29.3 million dozen as compared with the May estimate of 36.2 million dozen and 26.4 million dozen during June, 1951. The estimate of egg production during the first six months of 1952 was 214.3 million dozen compared to 178.0 million dozen during the same six months of 1951.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during June was 15.5 eggs compared with 17.4 eggs last month.

Producers sold 23.2 million dozen eggs for market during June compared with 28.5 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during June was 5.5 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during June 1952 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,518,442 pounds.
