## POULTRY ESTIMATES

## SEPTEMBER 1952

The estimated production of eggs in Canada \(\frac{1}{2}\) during September was 26.1 million dozen as compared with the August estimate of 24.4 million dozen and 22.8 million dozen during September, 1951. The estimate of egg production during the first nine months of 1952 was 273.7 million dozen compared to 247.0 million dozen during the same nine months of 1951.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during September was 14.2 eggs as compared with 14.9 eggs last month,

Producers sold 21.2 million dozen eggs for market during September compared with 18.9 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during September was 4.6 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during September, 1952 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 201,000 pounds.
