The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1 during January was 37.7 million dozen as compared with the December estimate of 37.4 million dozen.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during January was 14.8 eggs as compared with 14.7 during December.

Producers sold 31.3 million dozen eggs for market during January compared with 322.3 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during January was 4.4 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during January, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 686,189 pounds.
