#### POULTRY ESTIMATES

#### OCTOBER 1953

The estimated production of eggs in Canada \(\frac{1}{2}\) during October was 26.8 million dozen as compared with the September estimate of 23.9 million dozen and 26.1 million dozen during October, 1952. The estimate of egg production during the first ten months of 1953 was 286.4 million dozen compared to 281.3 million dozen during the same ten months of 1952.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during October was 14.2 eggs as compared with 14.0 eggs last month.

Producers sold 22.6 million dozen eggs for market during October compared with 19.4 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during October was 3.8 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during October, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 81,718 pounds.
