POULTRY ESTIMATES

## NOVEMBER 1953

The estimated production of eggs in Canada  $\frac{1}{2}$  during November was 29.9 million dozen as compared with the October estimate of 26.8 million dozen and 28.4 million dozen during November, 1952. The estimate of egg production during the first eleven months of 1953 was 316.2 million dozen compared to 309.7 million dozen during the same eleven months of 1952.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during November was 14.9 eggs as compared with 14.2 eggs last month and 13.7 in November 1952, reflecting, in part, the effect of very favourable weather conditions this November.

Producers sold 24.8 million dozen eggs for market during November compared with 22.6 million dozen eggs during October and 24.3 in November 1952. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during November was 3.7 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during November, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 54,739 pounds.
