POULTRY ESTIMATES

DECEMBER, 1953

The estimated production of eggs in Canada during December was 33.7 million dozen as compared with the November estimate of 29.9 million dozen and 31.9 million dozen during December, 1952. The preliminary estimate of egg production during 1953 was 349.9 million dozen compared to 341.5 million dozen during 1952. The revised estimates will be published when the December 1 Survey figures are available.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during December was 15.6 eggs as compared with 14.9 eggs last month and 14.8 in December 1952.

Producers sold 28.3 million dozen eggs for market during December compared with 24.8 million dozen eggs during November and 27.5 in December 1952. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during December was 4.1 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during December, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 284,907 pounds.
