POULTRY ESTIMATES

FEBRUARY 1953

The estimated production of eggs in Canada $\frac{1}{2}$ during February was 35.3 million dozen as compared with the January estimate of 37.7 million dozen. Egg production during the first two months of 1953 is estimated at 73 million dozen.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during February was 14.2 eggs as compared with 14.8 during January.

Producers sold 27.4 million dozen eggs for market during February compared with 31.3 million dozen eggs during the previous month. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during February was 4.5 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during February, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 769,647 pounds.
