#### POULTRY ESTIMATES

### APRIL 1953

The estimated production of eggs in Canada  $\frac{1}{2}$  during April was 33.1 million dozen as compared with the revised  $\frac{2}{2}$  March estimate of 34.2 million dozen and 34.3 million dozen during April last year. Egg production during the first four months of 1953 is estimated at 129.5 million dozen, 100,000 dozen below the first four months of 1952.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during April was 17.2, the same as during March and slightly below the 18.0 eggs per hen recorded during April, 1952.

Producers sold 24.0 million dozen eggs for market during April compared with a revised <sup>2</sup>/March estimate of 25.0 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by\_producers\_during April was 5.3 million dozen.

**FROZEN EGGS:** Production of frozen eggs during April, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,147,758 pounds.
