POULTRY ESTIMATES

MAY 1953

The estimated production of eggs in Canada $\frac{1}{2}$ during May was 31.5 million dozen as compared with the revised $\frac{2}{2}$ April estimate of 33.1 million dozen and 31.9 million dozen during May last year. Egg Production during the first five months of 1953 is estimated at 161.1 million dozen, 466,000 dozen below the first five months of 1952.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age during May was 17.2, the same as during April and slightly below the 18.0 eggs per hen recorded during May, 1952.

Producers sold 24.3 million dozen eggs for market during May compared with a revised 2/ April estimate of 24.0 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during May was 5.0 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during May, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,455,850 pounds.
