POULTRY ESTIMATES

June, 1953

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during June was 27.2 million dozen as compared with the revised 2/ May estimate of 31.5 million dozen and 25.7 million dozen during June last year. Egg production during the first six months of 1953 is estimated at 188.3 million dozen, 1 million dozen above the first six months of 1952.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age was 15.6 during June, 1.6 less than during May and slightly below the 15.8 eggs per hen recorded during June, 1952.

Producers sold 21.1 million dozen eggs for market during June compared with a revised 2/ May estimate of 24.3 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during June was 4.7 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during June, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 3,284,117 pounds.
