POULTRY ESTIMATES

JULY 1953

The estimated production of eggs in Canada ¹/_{during July} was 25.1 million dozen as compared with the revised ²/_{June} estimate of 27.2 million dozen and 22.5 million dozen during July last year. Egg production during the first seven months of 1953 is estimated at 213.3 million dozen, 4 million dozen above the first seven months of 1952.

Average egg production per hen over six months of age was 15.2 during June, .4 less than during June and slightly above the 14.9 eggs per hen recorded during July 1952.

Producers sold 20.0 million dozen eggs for market during July compared with a revised 2 June estimate of 21.1 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during July was 4.5 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during June, 1953 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,301,056 pounds.
