

PRODUCTION OF EGGS

December, 1954



The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during December was 35.4 million dozen as compared with the November estimate of 31.7 million dozen and the 35.3 million dozen during December last year. The preliminary estimate of egg production in 1954 was 378.9 million dozen compared with 353.2 million dozen in 1953.

Average egg production per layer during December was 14.4 eggs compared with 12.7 eggs last month. The rate of lay for December, 1953 was 15.7 but this figure is not directly comparable since egg production during 1953 was based on eggs per hen over six months old.

Producers sold 30.7 million dozen eggs for market during December compared with the November estimate of 27.2 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during December was 4.2 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during October, 1954 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 487,439 pounds.
