PRODUCTION OF EGES

APRIL 1954

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/during April was 38.2 million dozen as compared with the March estimate of 39.9 million dozen and 32.9 million dozen during April, 1953.

Average egg production per layer during April was 16.9 eggs as compared with 16.8 eggs last month. The egg production figure for April 1953 was 17.1 but this figure is not directly comparable since egg production during 1953 was based on eggs per hen over 6 months old. The proportion of laying pullets under 6 months to Hens over 6 months old was however, quite small in April.

Producers sold 29.5 million dozen eggs for market during April compared with 31.1 million dozen eggs during March and 25.8 in April 1953. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during April was 5.2 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during April, 1954 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 1,542,396 pounds.
