#### PRODUCTION OF EGGS

#### MAY 1954

The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during May was 36.2 million dozen as compared with the April estimate of 38.2 million dozen and 31.2 million dozen during May, 1953.

Average egg production per layer during May was 16.8 eggs as compared with 16.9 eggs last month. The egg production figure for May 1953 was 17.2 but this figure is not directly comparable since egg production during 1953 was based on eggs per hen over 6 months old. The proportion of laying pullets under 6 months to Hens over 6 months old was however, quite small in May.

Producers sold 29.2 million dozen eggs for market during May compared with 29.5 million dozen eggs during April and 25.2 in May 1953. The estimated consumption of eggs by producers during May was 5.2 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Production of frozen eggs during May, 1954 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,134,343 pounds.
