

PRODUCTION OF EGGS

October, 1955



The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during October was 31.3 million dozen as compared with the September estimate of 27.5 and the 31.2 million dozen during October last year. The estimate of egg production during the first ten months of 1955 was 315.7 million dozen compared with 318.1 million dozen for the same period in 1954.

Average egg production per layer during October was 12.4 eggs compared with 11.6 eggs last month. The rate of lay for October, 1954 was 11.4.

Producers sold 26.3 million dozen eggs for market during October compared with the September estimate of 23.1 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during October was 3.9 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during October, 1955 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 467,460 pounds.
