

#### PRODUCTION OF EGGS

November, 1955



The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during November was 34.1 million dozen as compared with the October estimate of 31.3 and the 34.9 million dozen during November last year. The estimate of egg production during the first eleven months of 1955 was 349.8 million dozen compared with 353.1 million dozen for the same period in 1954.

Average egg production per layer during November was 13.4 eggs compared with 12.4 eggs last month. The rate of lay for November, 1954 was 12.0.

Producers sold 29.3 million dozen eggs for market during November compared with the October estimate of 26.3 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during November was 3.7 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during November, 1955 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 184,072 pounds.
