PRODUCTION OF EGGS

December, 1955



The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/during December was 37.1 million dozen as compared with the November estimate of 34.1 and the 39.3 million dozen during December last year. The estimate of egg production during 1955 was 386.9 million dozen compared with 392.4 million dozen for 1954. Revised estimates will be published when processing of data from the December 1 semi-annual poultry survey has been completed.

Average egg production per layer during December was 14.8 eggs compared with 13.4 eggs last month. The rate of lay for December, 1954 was 13.9.

Producers sold 31.5 million dozen eggs for market during December compared with the November estimate of 29.3 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during December was 4.0 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during December, 1955 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 67,934 pounds.
