

PRODUCTION OF EGGS

February, 1955



The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during February was 35.2 million dozen as compared with the January estimate of 38.6 million dozen and the 33.6 million dozen during February last year. The estimate of egg production during the first two months of 1955 was 73.8 million dozen compared with 69.7 million dosen for the same period in 1954.

Average egg production per layer during February was 13.9 eggs compared with 14.8 eggs last month. The rate of lay for February, 1954 was 14.0.

Producers sold 28.2 million dozen eggs for market during February compared with the January estimate of 32.8 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during February was 4.2 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during February. 1955 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 2,770,954 pounds.
