

PRODUCTION OF EGGS

March, 1955



The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during March was 39.4 million dozen as compared with the February estimate of 35.2 million dozen and the 37.7 million dozen during March last year. The estimate of egg production during the first three months of 1955 was 113.3 million dozen compared with 107.4 million dozen for the same period in 1954.

Average egg production per layer during March was 16.2 eggs compared with 13.9 eggs last month. The rate of lay for March, 1954 was 16.8.

Producers sold 30.9 million dozen eggs for market during March compared with the February estimate of 28.2 million dozen. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during March was 4.8 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during March. 1955 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 920.841 pounds.
