PRODUCTION OF EGGS

April, 1955



The estimated production of eggs in Canada 1/ during April was 39.0 million dozen as compared with the March estimate of 39.4 million dozen and the 35.3 million dozen during April last year. The estimate of egg production during the first four months of 1955 was 152.2 million dozen compared with 142.7 million dozen for the same period in 1954.

Average egg production per layer during April was 16.8 eggs compared with 16.2 eggs last month. The rate of lay for April, 1954 was 17.6.

Producers sold 30.9 million dozen eggs for market during April. This was equal to marketings in March this year and almost 10 per cent greater than marketings in April, 1954. Estimated consumption of eggs by producers during April was 5.1 million dozen.

FROZEN EGGS: Processing to frozen egg during April, 1955 in all plants under inspection reporting to the Department of Agriculture and in uninspected plants reporting to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics was 1,065,883 pounds.
